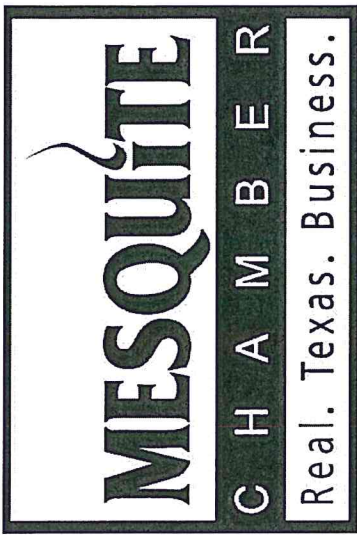

1 – 10	\$260	Financial Institutions: \$30 per each \$1 million in deposits; Minimum investment \$315
11 – 20	\$ 300	Shopping Centers & Office Developments: \$2.00 per each 1,000 square feet; Minimum investment \$260
21 - 50	\$ 470	Apartments: \$2.00 per unit; Minimum investment \$260.
51 – 100	\$ 600	Hotels & Motels: \$4.00 per bed; Minimum investment \$260.
101 – 250	\$ 800	Hospitals: \$4.00 per bed; Minimum investment \$260.
250 and above	\$1300	Non-Profit Organizations: \$165 per organization (only for chartered non-profit organizations; must furnish copy of charter or approval letter from Secretary of State of Texas). Holds no voting status. Personal: \$165 per individual. (Not available to individuals who operate a business or hold a Texas Sales I.D. number). Holds no voting status.
